ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

[re: Docket No. 30]

On June 25, 2012, the Court held a status conference in this involuntary bankruptcy case (the “Involuntary”) to again consider whether (i) the Involuntary should be dismissed, (ii) the order entered by this Court on October 4, 2011 [Docket No. 58] to abstain from further proceedings (the “Abstention Order”) should be continued, or (iii) the Involuntary should be activated. Having considered the positions of the parties and the statements at the hearing on June 25, 2012, the Court hereby finds that dismissing the Involuntary is in the best interest of all the parties, the alleged involuntary debtor and its creditors and in the interest of justice. . Furthermore, the Court finds that the receivership action pending in state court has progressed such that there is no further need to maintain this Involuntary as a suspended case. It is therefore,

ORDERED that this Involuntary shall be dismissed pursuant to Bankruptcy Code § 305(a). It is further,

ORDERED that all motions pending in this Involuntary and not otherwise resolved by this Order are hereby denied. It is further

ORDERED that this Order is effective immediately upon entry.
