ORDER ON RECEIVER'S TENTH MOTION FOR APPROVA SETTLEMENTS WITH THIRD-PARTY DEFENDANT/LICENSEES

On the 8 day of January, 2014, the Court heard the Receiver's Ninth Motion for Approval of Settlements with Third-Party Defendant Licensees Jose (Joe) Fernandez ("Defendant").
